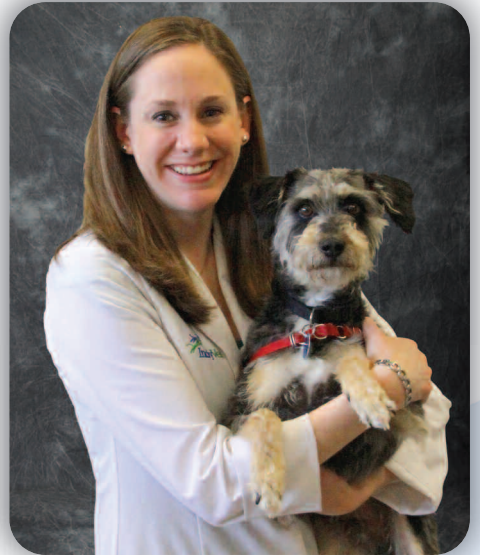
Julie Trzil, DVM, MS, DACVIM-SAIM
